This book is a MUST HAVE history of our glorious past!

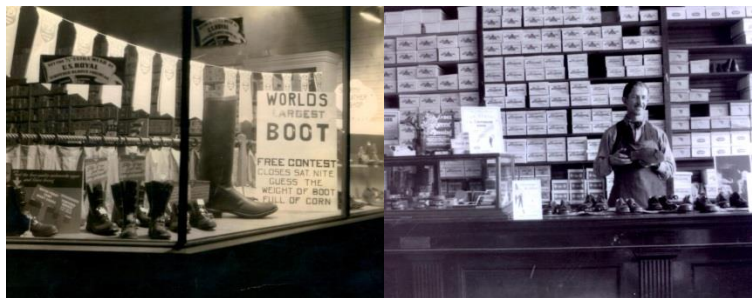

Carl Villiger shown at far right in his shoe store... Parker's display window at 1147 N Niles. In the summer of 1939, Hilton Parker, who managed the Metamora Shoe Store, bought the store from owner C.O. Villiger.

To help get the inventory in balance, Villiger held a Stock Reduction Sale – you could buy “women's Oxfords for 50¢ a pair” – but for “cash only.” Mr. Parker continued the sale and later featured “children's kedettes – 97¢.” To see the old ads and the announcement from the Herald, visit historicmetamora.com.
